

# Eitt post-vakstrar Evropa er avgerandi fyrir at yvirliva og fremja trivnað, ljóðar áheitan frá yvir 400 sivilsamfelagsbólkum og serfrøðingum

**Samstundis sum politiskir leiðarar savnast fyrir aðru ferð til ráðstevnu í Evropaparlamentinum um, hvussu vit kunnu flyta okkum burtur úr vakstrarparadigminum, síggja vit, undirritaðu vísindafólk og sivilsamfelagsfelagskapir, ta geopolitisku kreppuna sum ein möguleika fyrir at leysríva okkum frá tí sosialt- og umhvørviskaðandi kappingini um vökstur. Vit eggja í staðin til samstarv um øktan trivnað (wellbeing).**

Tað finst einki empiriskt grundarlag fyrir, at tað í nøktandi mun ber til at sundurskilja búskaparvökstur frá ovþyrjing av umhvørvinum altjóða sæð. Strembanin eftir óendaligum búskaparvökstri hjá háinntökulondunum er ein trupulleiki, tí hon antin minkar um ella útjavnar náttúru- og umhvørvispolitisku tiltökini, sum vit seta í verk. Veðurlagsóskilið og umhvørvisoyðingin, sum okkara samfélög er tongt at, er ein eksistentiell hóttan móti friði, vatn- og mattryggleika og demokratinum.

At menna okkum fram móti einum post-vakstrarbúskapi snýr seg ikki einans um at yvirliva, men eisini um at fremja trivnað. Hetta krevur eina demokratiskt planlagda og rættvísá niðurskalering av framleiðslu og nýtslu - onkuntið kallað 'avvökstur' - í teimum londum, sum í dag hava eina ovurnýtslu av náttúrutilfeingi. Ein tilík gongd hevði í

veruleikanum verið ein europeisk friðarverkætlan, tí stóðan í dag er, at búskaparvökstur skapar konfliktir bæði í og utan fyrir Evropa.

Í háinntøkulondunum merkir eitt lægri vistfrøðiligt fótaspor ikki neyðturviliga verri lívskor. Ein politikkur grundaður á eitt prinsipp um “nóg mikið” (sufficiency), ið leggur áherðslu á sparsemi, avmarkingar av tilfeingisnýtslu og niðursetta arbeiðstíð, kann ókja um trivnaðin og samstundis minka um trústið á umhvørvið. Hetta skapar möguleikar fyrir burðardyggari vælferð utan vökstur.

Fyri at tryggja hægst möguligan trivnað og vælferð við lægst möguligum fótasporum er neyðugt, at vit grundleggjandi endurhugsa bæði endamálið við búskapinum og eisini búskaparligu spælireglurnar. Í einum post-vakstrarbúskapi verður núverandi denturin á at skapa kvantitativan vökstur skiftur út við ein regenerativan búskap, ið hefur sum endamál at skapa trivnað og at levera kvalitativa vælferð við at nøkta törvinum hjá öllum innan fyrir jarðarinnar mörk – eins og í búskaparfrymlinum “Doughtnut Economics”.

Marknaðurin vísir seg ikki at vera egnaður sum grundarlag fyrir teimum týdningarmiklastu avgerðunum í okkara samfelag. Um búskapurin skal tæna fólkinum og ikki umvent, má fólkid fáa stýringina av búskapinum aftur. Fyri at broyta spælireglurnar eiga vit at læra frá eksisterandi átökum, t.d. at menna og spreiða frymilin um almannagagnlig samvinnufelög kring alt Evropa.

Í ljósinum av hesum bráðfeingis avbjóðingum og stimbrandi möguleikum heita vit á Evropeiska Samveldið, tess stovnar og limalond at seta í verk:

1. **Post-vökstur stovnar í Evropa:** at seta á stovn varandi bygnaðir í ES-kommissiónini, ráðnum, parlamentinum og í limalondunum, sum skulu gera metingar av ymiskum strategi- og planleggingarárbeidi, ið skal til fyrir at útinna ein post-vakstrarbúskap.
2. **Eina evropeiska Green Deal fyrir post-vökstur:** at gera eina stevnuskrá, sum er grundað á eina brotingartilgongd, ið leggur seg eftir at skapa eina blómandi framtíð innan jarðarinnar mörk við avvökstri sum eitt neyðugt skiftisskeið fram ímóti einum post-vakstrar búskapi.
3. **Post-vakstrar politikkur** er grundaður á tey fýra prinsippini um:
  - **Biokapasitet:** útfasing av lívrunnum brennievni, mörk fyrir rávøruúrdrátti og náttúruverndar- og náttúruendurbøtingarátök, sum skapa eina sunna og

mótstöðuföra jörð, skóg, hav og aðrar vistskipanir. Til dømis eina avtalu um ikki at spreiða lívrunnin brennievni, eina lög um tilfeingisrættvísí og -mótstöðuföri, sum umfatar eitt bindandi mál fyrir minking av materiella fótasporinum og veruliga økisgrundaða náttúruendurböting.

- **Rættvísí:** skattaamboð, ið eru við til at fremja eitt javnari samfelag við at burturbeina ógvusligan inntøkuójavna og ekstremt ríkidömi, eins og ovurvinning. Til dømis ein CO2-ognarskat og bæði eitt lágmark og eitt hámark fyrir inntökustöði.
- **Vælfærð til øll:** eina tryggjaða atgongd til týðandi infrakervið umvegis ein betraðan umhvørvisvinarligan vælferðarstat. Til dømis algildar grundtænastur (íroknað menniskjarætturin til heilsu, flutning, røkt, býli, útbúgving, sosiala vernd, o.s.fr.)
- **Virkið demokrati:** borgarafundir við heimild at orða sosialt hóskandi strategiir og at styrkja politikk, ið tekur útgangsstöði í jarðarinnar mörkum, rættvísí og trivnaði fyrir øll, umframt einum sterkari leikluti hjá fakfelögum. Til dømis ein pall, har tað ber til at kjaka um staðbundnar tørvir, veðurlagslögir, og at menna luttakaragrundaðar fíggjarætlanir.

Tað eru fimm ár síðan, tann fyrsta “post-vøkstur”- ráðstevnan var. Í civilsamfelagnum og í vísindaheiminum eru vakstrarkritiskar hugsanir vorðnar alsamt sterkari. Í Evropaparlamentinum verður í hesum dögum kjakað um smálutirnar í hesum hugsanum saman við Evropakommissiónini. Vísindalig vitan og politiskt innlit er til taks fyrir at hugsanirnar um avvøkstur og post-vøkstur verða til veruleika. Kreppurnar, sum vit í dag eru í, eru eisini ein gyltur möguleiki fyrir at skapa eina nýggja skipan, ið er fær fyrir at tryggja trivnað og vælferð til øll, samstundis sum hon loyvir eitt blómmandi demokratiskt lív og einum spakuligari og góð hugaþriggjum máta at liva uppá.
